BIST Sixth Form Dress Code

Students should dress in business casual attire. Their dress should be appropriate for preparing them for the world of work and applications for Higher Education.

DRESS CODE - Business Casual

Students are expected to wear appropriate and respectful dress at all times, unless otherwise indicated by the teacher or the administrative office for special events or field trips. If students arrive at school dressed inappropriately for an educational setting, parents will be contacted immediately and requested to bring appropriate clothing to school. Hair longer than shoulder-length should be tied up for neatness and safety.

Shirt or Blouse (plain colours)

Trousers (dark/plain colours) or Skirt (no lower than just above knee length) or Summer dress

Smart Polo shirt (plain colours)

Blazer or smart jacket in winter (dark/plain colours)

Sweater or BIST branded hoodie

Shorts (of appropriate length, smart, plain colours)

Shoes or dark coloured trainers

Students are expected to have the appropriate clothes for Physical Education (PE) to school, as follows:

- For PE class, a t-shirt, a house t-shirt, shorts (or tracksuit/leggings), and sports shoes/trainers.
