COBIS Accreditation Report

Last week, we shared, via email and Classlist, our COBIS Accreditation report. For those of you who have not seen our report, a copy can be found here. We are all very proud of the report as it highlights many of the great things happening at BIST. We are particularly pleased with the special commendations we received in many important areas - our curriculum design and structure; the attitude of students to learning; how leadership promotes wellbeing; the focus on high expectations and the enrichment of student experience; the school's vision; the openness and efficiency of communications; our extracurricular and enrichment opportunities; and the opportunities offered to students to engage with the outside world. Even more pleasing was the award of Beacon Status for our promotion of wellbeing and our school's vision. Beacon Status means that we are recommended to other COBIS schools as a source of advice on these issues. BIST has been a member of COBIS since 2015 and was first accredited under the Patron's Accreditation scheme in 2019, the 17th of the 270 COBIS member schools to go through the process. The Patron's Accreditation has since been re-named as COBIS Accredited Member status. Membership of COBIS requires schools to successfully complete what is known as Compliance (and we congratulate our sister school BGA on becoming a COBIS member through this route). Schools are not compelled or required to complete COBIS Accreditation to be members, but those schools who want to test themselves and be judged against the COBIS accreditation standards can do so. We would like to thank all in our community for their contributions to this process and to making our school such a great institution.
