DEAR PARENTS

This week and next week are four day weeks, but busy ones! The Primary school students will complete their GL Progress Tests in English, Maths and Science during the week. Parental reports for these will be sent out with the End of Year Reports. Students in Years 7 to 10 will be sitting their summer assessments next week (and GL Progress Tests in Years 7 to 9). The Year 10 assessments are a good preparation for the real examinations the following year and will use relevant sections of real past exam papers. Our Year 11 to 13 students are progressing through their IGCSE, AS Level and A Level examinations - as of today 872 examinations have been sat by 93 students; this is 77% of the total number of exams being sat this year. The students have shown great resilience and dedication throughout the exam period in what is a test of their character as well as their subject knowledge.
