REQUIRED SCHOOL UNIFORM

Students are expected to wear the designated school uniform at all times, unless indicated by the teacher or administration for special events or field trips.

Students arriving to school not wearing the appropriate uniform may be asked to return home to change. Appropriate dress means wearing clothes that are sensitive to multicultural norms and does not lead to any offence.

*Trousers - this means plain tailored trousers, chinos or slacks and excludes jogging/ sports trousers, leggings and cargo pants (with pockets on the sides) No large logos are acceptable.

The British International School of Tbilisi logo/crest is available for purchase at the school administrative office. This logo can be ironed onto the shirt.

It is the school's expectation that students are appropriately* dressed, have appropriate* hairstyles and limited jewellery. This is for reasons of health and safety and to ensure that students portray a positive image of themselves and the school.

2024/5 PE Policy: Students should be wearing appropriate sports clothing for PE. BIST house PE shirts are available from the school shop.
