CHARITY UPDATE

This academic year has been a hugely successful one for charitable endeavours at BIST. Across the school, we have participated in numerous collections and fundraising events to support our local community. One of the highlights was the Toy Sale, which raised an impressive 2,412 GEL.

In Years 1 and 2, the students partnered with DOG as their Community Partnership Link. As part of their IPC topic 'A Day in the Life', a representative from DOG visited the classes to talk about their work. The students created posters to encourage people to visit and walk the dogs. Their fundraising efforts enabled them to purchase five paddling pools and over 200 kg of dog food. Our whole-school June collection for DOG was gratefully received, and they appreciated the donated items.

In Years 3 and 4, the children supported Tsodoreti Park by participating in a litter-picking activity to help care for their local environment. They also chose to donate items to CARITAS, using the funds raised to purchase sports equipment, educational games and resources, and stationery for children aged from 6 - 17 years old.

In Years 5 and 6, the students collaborated with Lisi Public School. They successfully met their fundraising target, raising over 1,000 euros through events such as an ice cream sale and a hot chocolate sale. They also organised an Easter Egg Hunt for the students at the public school. With the funds, they were able to purchase a microscope, a PA sound system, goal posts, a basketball net, an outdoor table tennis table, and other valuable educational resources.

In June, our donation drive for the Martkopi Refugee Camp/World Vision was our most successful collection yet—the BIST van was filled with generously donated items. They were truly grateful for the support.
